

Owner Occupied Households

This map shows the percent of occupied households that are owner occupied. About 55% of housing in the Metropolitan Planning Organization area census tracts are owner occupied.

Data for this map is from the Census 2010 which represents a full count of households. A home is considered owned if it is mortgaged, has another form of debt arrangement, or is paid in full, even if the land is leased.

The full range of data for each map has been divided into thirds to create low, medium, and high categories. A histogram is also included to show that the data is not necessarily distributed equally across these three categories. About 63% of owner households are in the top 31 tracts in the highest category.
